

Thank you for selecting Stonewood Stables for your child's summer adventure. We are proud of our summer program and look forward to your child's participation. On this site you will find a Camper's Questionnaire, Waiver, and Emergency Contact Information form, which need to be completed and returned before your child's first day at camp. Also enclosed is the daily schedule for your information. Listed below are items, which your child should bring with them to camp. At check in, on Monday, you will receive a picture order packet from Bellavita Photography. Their pictures are wonderful and have been a huge success for the past few years.

Camp shirts will be sold at the start of camp. Polo shirts for \$25 and T-shirts for \$20. Your child will need to have a riding helmet (Pony Club or S.E.I. approved). You can purchase your helmet from any reputable tack store. (Please make sure they are Pony Club or S.E.I. approved).

ALL CAMPERS NEED:

- Helmet (Equestrian Riding Helmet Pony Club or S.E.I. approved)
- Shoes – riding boots, or sneakers, or hiking boots
- Long pants – either riding britches or jeans or cotton sweat pants
- Long socks – sport socks
- Sun block
- Insect repellent
- Change of clothes – shirt, shorts
- Change for coke machines/snacks
- Soft Drinks – .50 Snack Machine - .50 Bottled Water - .75
- DAY CAMPERS NEED TO BRING A SACK LUNCH

OVERNIGHT CAMPERS NEED IN ADDITION:

- Sleeping bag, pillow
- Trunk or foot locker
- Clothes for week including extra riding pants, jeans, shorts,
- Shirts, socks, underwear, etc.
- Change of shoes
- Flash light
- Wash cloths and toiletries

Please put child's name on each item. Any one bringing a cell phone will need to keep it with their baggage and not on person. Any overnight campers with cell phones will need to leave them turned off and downstairs on the kitchen table at night. We encourage each child to call home every evening and will supply phones for this purpose.

Overnight Campers are encouraged to check in early. The cost of checking in on Sunday afternoon (after 4:00) and staying Sunday night is \$50. Campers checking in on Friday evening or Saturday morning and participating in riding activities throughout the weekend will need to pay the weekend camp fee of \$200. Campers checking in on Saturday afternoon (after 4:00) will need to pay an additional \$100. This is a great way for the child to settle in and get a head start on riding before regular classes start on Monday morning. Overnight Campers who are attending consecutive weeks are welcome to stay through the weekend. Additional cost is \$200. Our weekend schedule varies, however, includes trail rides, English and Western lessons plus swimming, etc.

Waiver of Liability

Stonewood Stables, Inc. will accept the child(ren) for participation only if the parent or legal guardian accepts certain responsibilities for him or herself and/or the child(ren), and releases all persons and parties through whom the programs are facilitated from liabilities under most circumstances. Signature below is required for participation in Stonewood Stable, Inc.'s programs.

By signing this document, the parent or legal guardian confirms that he or she has authority to sign, has read the entire document, and has understanding that the document waives certain rights of the child(ren) and the person signing.

The parent or legal guardian acknowledges that the child(ren)'s participation is voluntary. The undersigned further acknowledges that participation in equine activities, swimming, athletics, and other forms of physical recreational activities can result in personal injury. While Stonewood Stables, Inc. operates in a reasonable and safe manner, the undersigned acknowledges that many of the activities in which the child(ren) will participate will involve physical activities which inherently may result in physical injury even if the program is conducted with appropriate levels of care and supervision.

Under Georgia law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 12 of the Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.

The undersigned expressly acknowledges that neither Stonewood Stables, Inc., nor any of its employees, agents or other representatives can be responsible for any injuries to person or property arising out of participation of the child(ren) in any program. In consideration of the benefits to be derived by the child(ren) and the undersigned from participation by the child(ren) in the activities, the undersigned, on behalf of him or herself and the child(ren) and any other person who may have any rights to assert any claim on behalf of himself or herself or the child(ren) with respect to injuries to the person or property of the child(ren), hereby waives and releases any claims for damages against Stonewood Stables, Inc. and/or its representatives, employees, and/or any landholder arising out of injury or damage to the person or property of the child(ren) and hereby releases and forever discharges Stonewood Stables, Inc. and its representatives, employees, and/or landholder from all actions, causes of actions, suits, damages, judgments, claims and demands whatsoever, in law or equity, which the undersigned or the child(ren) or their respective guardians, representatives, heirs, executors, administrators, successors or assigns may have against Stonewood Stables, Inc. and/or its representatives, employees, agents, and/or landholder arising out of the participation by the child(ren) in programs and events facilitated by Stonewood Stables, Inc.
